USE DIRECTIONS:

Turf: Apply Iron Chelate 20% Fe at a rate of 1.25–5 lbs. per acre $(0.5-2 \text{ oz.}/1,000 \text{ ft}^2)$ in 45-90 gallons spray solution per acre $(1-2 \text{ gal per } 1,000 \text{ ft}^2)$. Severe iron deficiency may require a higher application rate of 10 lbs. per acre $(4 \text{ oz.} / 1,000 \text{ ft}^2)$

Always add Iron Chelate 20% Fe to the water first and then add other fertilizers. It is advisable to do a jar test before addition to any pesticides.

CAUTION: This product contains Iron. Should be used as recommended. Misuse may prove harmful. Do not use with bordeaux, spray lime, or highly alkaline spray materials, always add Iron Chelate 20% Fe to spray mixture as the first ingredient and dissolve completely.
